
Compass

For what is it helpful?

No matter where you stand on Earth, you can hold a compass in your hand and it will point toward the North Pole. What an unbelievably neat and amazing thing! Imagine that you are in the middle of the

ocean, and you are looking all around you in every direction and all you can see is water, and it is overcast so you cannot see the sun... How in the world would you know which way to go unless you had a compass to tell you which way is "up"? Long before GPS satellites and other high-tech navigational aids, the compass gave humans an easy and inexpensive way to orient themselves.



How do use a compass?

Use the new direction to navigate. Keep the compass in front of you so that the directional arrow points away from you. This direction will lead you to your destination. Turn your body until the compass needle aligns with the orientation arrow.
